



## Seeking 25 Students Interested in Computer Camp Experience

[BDPA Philadelphia](#) will train 25 high school students in their 2008 Student Information Technology Education & Scholarship (SITES) program. The SITES program in Philadelphia is divided into three components: Computer Camp, Youth Technology Seminar Series, and High School Computer Competition .

BDPA provides a positive beacon of hope for our youth and high school students as they are introduced to various aspects of Information Technology, including advance research on IT topics, web application development (Basic HTML, FrontPage, SQL, ASP), web application programming, logic and advanced computer concepts. The 25 young people selected will participate in weekly programs that begin on Saturday, February 16, 2008 at Deloitte's downtown office located at 1700 Market St. Philadelphia, Pa.

Interested students will need to have the following qualifications:

- Must be in 8th - 12th grade
- Interested in Information Technology
- Good attendance
- Cooperation
- Participation

A smaller subset of students may be interested in participating in the National BDPA High School Computer Competition (HSCC) as the Philadelphia chapter works to develop a team that can defeat the current national champions. [HSCC participants are eligible for scholarships](#). Qualifications for students selected for the HSCC (limited space):

- Must be in 9th - 12th grade
- Minimum 2.5 G.P.A.
- Display a strong interest in Information Technology (demonstrable programming and web development skills)
- Display natural ability
- Willing to participate in class
- Cooperative spirit (teamwork is very important here)
- Good attendance
